Delta Dental Update

Please be advised that some non participating dentists are requiring that services be paid in full at the time of service since Delta Dental will be paying the participant if the provider that is utilized is not a Delta Dental participating provider. If you utilize a participating Delta Dental provider, the provider will submit the claim and payment will be paid directly to the dental provider.

Also, providers may have an office policy that requires a written pre-authorization before proposed services are provided. Pre-Authorizations are not required by Delta Dental, but a pre-determination is strongly recommended if total charges are expected to exceed \$300.00.

Delta acts promptly in returning the predetermination voucher to your dentist and will also send a copy to you explaining eligibility, scope of benefits, and the period of time for completion of services.

New Law Changes USERRA Requirements

If you are or may be called to active military service, you should know that the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act ("USERRA") has recently been changed to provide additional coverage for you.

Continuation Coverage Extension

USERRA contains a requirement that eligible employees who are called up to active military service must be allowed to continue group health coverage for themselves, their spouse and their covered dependents for up to 18 months. **The new law extends that period from 18 months to 24 months.** The extended continuation period is effective for individuals first electing coverage beginning on and after December 10, 2004. Therefore, the extension will not extend the continuation coverage period of an individual whose continuation coverage began before December 10, 2004.

USERRA Notice

The Act also requires that your employer provide an annual notice of USERRA rights and obligations to employees entering military service. This notice requirement can be met by posting the notice in a location where the employer customarily places notices to employees. (The requirement also applies to unions that operate hiring halls.)

SPECIAL ANNUAL NOTICE

The Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998

Under a federal law called the **Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998**, the Fund is required to provide you with an annual notice of your rights under this Act. Please consider this information as the annual notice for 2005 of your rights under this important federal law.

The Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act requires the Fund to provide benefits for mastectomy related services including reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed and surgery to achieve symmetry between the breasts, prostheses, and complications resulting from a mastectomy,

including lymphedema. Any Fund deductibles and copayments that apply to other conditions also apply to the treatment related to the mastectomy. You should feel free to contact the Fund Administrator if you have any questions about your coverage. You can reach the Fund Administrator at **610-320-5500**.

This coverage is available under all plans of the Central Pennsylvania Teamsters Health and Welfare Fund and is subject to the relevant plan's deductibles and coinsurance provisions.

Suspension of Benefit Rules Mailing

Several times over the course of each participant's working career, the Pension Fund Office mails the participant a copy of the Fund's Suspension of Benefits Rules. A copy is sent to all participants during the month in which they will be turning ages 56 and 64, prior to reaching the normal retirement age under the RIP and DB plans. This notice is intended to advise you that once you reach normal retirement age, as prescribed by your plan of benefits, you are entitled to apply to retire from this Fund and receive your benefits as long as you are not in suspendible employment, which is defined in the notice. You are **not** required to retire; however, a determination of your eligibility to retire cannot commence until you complete the Fund's retirement application process. Additionally, the

Fund's Suspension of Benefits Rules are also included with every pension application which is issued to each participant as part of the retirement application process.

Once a participant retires from the Fund, they are subject to the Suspension of Benefits Rules. If at any time a retired participant is considering post-retirement employment, they are strongly urged to contact the Pension Fund Office to determine if such employment violates the Suspension of Benefits Rules of the Fund. Also, the Fund randomly issues a post-retirement employment questionnaire to retirees in pay status as another means of enforcing compliance with these rules. WHAT HAPPENS TO MY PENSION IF I SHOULD DIE BEFORE I RETIRE?

If you die before retirement, both the Retirement Income Plan 1987 ("RIP 1987") and Retirement Income Plan 2000 ("RIP 2000") provide for a Pre-Retirement Survivor Annuity payable to your spouse, which is equivalent to 100% of your Account balance. This benefit is payable in the form of a Single Life Annuity, unless your spouse elects to receive either a Lump-Sum Payment or Monthly Installments (payable until the Account balance is exhausted).

If you are single, or if your spouse gives written consent, you may designate another person(s) as your beneficiary(ies), who would receive 100% of your Account balance in the form of a Lump Sum Payment after your death.

The Defined Benefit Plan also provides for a Pre-Retirement Survivor Annuity, payable monthly to the surviving spouse of a vested Participant. Generally speaking, the amount of this monthly benefit is equal to the amount your spouse would have been entitled to receive under a Qualified Joint and 50% Survivor Annuity, computed as if you had:

- Terminated employment on the earlier of the date you were last employed in Covered Employment, or the date of your death,

- Survived to your earliest Retirement age with a Qualified Joint and 50% Survivor Annuity, and
- Died on the day after you reached your earliest Retirement age.

In addition, a small lump sum death benefit, based on the number of Years of Vested Service (prior to 1990) you completed under the Defined Benefit Plan (if applicable), may be payable to your designated beneficiary.

The above general description of the benefits available from each Plan is not intended to be all-encompassing. For a more complete description, please consult the official Plan Documents, or contact the Pension Fund Office. ■

SURROGATE PREGNANCY

The Trustees, after careful consideration of the facts, have decided against coverage for surrogate pregnancy. This would include any services that are related to the conception, pregnancy, or birth of a child in a surrogate pregnancy. If a child born through a surrogate pregnancy becomes an eligible dependent of a Fund participant, the Fund will provide benefits for the child in accordance with the terms of the Plan document.

All of the plans have been amended to exclude these services. ■

Recent Developments on Common Law Marriage in Pennsylvania

The Pennsylvania legislature recently passed a law under which **no common law marriage first entered into on or after January 2, 2005 shall be valid.** This law was signed by Governor Rendell on November 23, 2004. This new statute clarifies that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will not recognize common law marriages **first** entered into on or after January 2, 2005. The new statute specifically states that common law marriages validly entered into on or before January 1, 2005 shall remain valid.

The Trustees cannot honor a common law marriage that the parties entered into on or after January 2, 2005. If a Participant has not previously enrolled a common law spouse under the Funds and now wishes to prove that he had a common law marriage prior to January 2, 2005, the Participant must submit both the Funds' affidavit of common law marriage, signed by the Participant and the spouse (which specifically includes an affirmation that the parties have spoken to one another the present tense assertion that each intends to take the other as his or her lawful spouse) as well as at least three of the documents listed below, unless the Trustees, in their discretion, determine that one of the documents alone is dispositive regarding the existence of a common law marriage. These documents include:

- A lease or mortgage naming both parties;

- Tax returns for the immediately prior year or earlier listing the parties as filing "Married" (regardless of whether filed jointly or singly);
- Bank account documents listing both parties as holders of the account;
- Life insurance policies in which the parties name one another as the beneficiary;
- Credit card bills showing that the card is listed in the names of both parties;
- A determination by a state or federal agency (or court) treating the individual as the spouse of the participant (for example, a determination that the Social Security Administration is treating an individual as a spouse);
- Birth certificates of children showing the parties as the parents of the children.

The Trustees observe that the affidavit of common law marriage gives the Participant the opportunity to demonstrate to the Funds that a common law marriage exists. By signing the affidavit, the Participant and his or her spouse are affirming to the Funds their lawful married status. Because there is no common law divorce in Pennsylvania, the Funds' policies remains that in order to demonstrate that a common law marriage has been dissolved, the Participant must submit a divorce decree from a court of competent jurisdiction. ■

UNCOVERING MEDICAL FRAUD

While the vast majority of medical providers employ honest and upstanding people in their workplace, the Fund is well aware that medical fraud is on the upswing, which unnecessarily raises everyone's health care costs.

Common types of provider fraud would include providers that are billing for services that were never rendered, misrepresentation of services provided, or providing medically unnecessary services. We are asking all of our participants to carefully review the explanation of benefits that is sent to them when a medical claim is processed on their behalf. Verify that you did receive treatment on the date of service listed. If the services that were provided do not appear to be correct, contact the provider and request that the billed services be compared with the information listed in your medical history records for that date. The Fund should be notified if you or your eligible dependents have been billed for medical services that were never rendered or if you feel that the services have been misrepresented or were unnecessary. ■

Illegal Acts

None of the Central Pennsylvania Teamsters Health and Welfare Plans provide benefit coverage if the service is rendered as a result of participation in an illegal act, including drunk driving and illegal substance abuse. If you are covered under a plan that provides for mental illness and substance abuse benefits, you would have coverage under the mental illness/substance abuse provisions of your plan.

As an example, you are driving your car after visiting a friend and drinking a few beers and become involved in a traffic accident. A blood alcohol test performed at the hospital indicates a blood alcohol level over the .08 legal limit. The Fund would not pay any of the claims associated with the motor vehicle accident according to the exclusion provision of your plan since you were driving with a blood alcohol limit over .08 which is an illegal act. You do not have to be arrested or cited by the police for the Fund to consider an illegal act to have occurred. ■

Beneficiary Changes

This applies to Plan R2, Plan R4, Plan 13 and Plan 14 for participants covered under the Death and Dismemberment Option. Under the Health and Welfare Fund you are required to list all eligible dependents on the dependent information section of the Participant Application and Beneficiary form. This would include spouses that a participant is separated from and in the process of obtaining a divorce. **HOWEVER, THE BENEFICIARY MAY BE CHANGED AT ANY TIME IN THE HEALTH AND WELFARE FUND.**

The Fund is required to pay a death benefit to the person/persons that you have indicated on the beneficiary card. Please review your beneficiary information with the Fund Office. We have had several instances where participants did not

change their beneficiary and ex-wives received the applicable death benefit from the Fund. The Fund is **required** to pay the death benefit to the beneficiary listed on the application card.

For example, Joe Smith has a spouse, Jane, and two children, Bob and Katy. Joe is in the process of obtaining a divorce from Jane. The divorce is not final, so he must list Jane as his spouse, and Bob and Katy as his dependent children on the Dependent Information section of the Participant Application and Beneficiary form. Joe has decided to name his mother on the Beneficiary portion of the form. Joe's mother becomes the recipient of any death benefit proceeds as of the date that the Participant Application and Beneficiary form is received in the Fund office. ■

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS

There is a misconception with regard to the coverage provided by the Fund when the claim is the result of an injury due to a motor vehicle accident. The Fund will **only** cover medical expenses on a subrogated basis once the maximum liability has been paid by the motor vehicle insurance carrier. The Fund will **not** pay short-term disability benefits (except for the first 5 days of missed work). The only time the Fund will pay more than 5 days of short-term disability is when written proof is submitted verifying that the state in which you reside does not allow you to purchase wage loss protection from your motor vehicle insurance carrier. You should contact your motor vehicle insurance carrier to evaluate the extent to which you are covered for wage loss benefits as a result of a motor vehicle accident. Do not wait until you have an accident to find out you have no wage loss coverage under your policy. Payment for the first 5 days of short-term disability benefits does not apply to motorcycle accidents. There are no short-term disability benefits payable for injuries sustained as a result of a motorcycle accident. ■

Annual Pension Statements Get an Updated Look

The Fund Office is sure that most everyone is aware that the Annual Statements issued by the Pension Fund went through a major overhauling this year for the 2004 reporting period. The Fund Office has been in the process of mailing statements to participants since the middle of July. In previous years, the Statements were typically issued by the Fund Office within the first couple of months after the start of the new year. Recall, that in prior years, statements were issued separately for each benefit plan under which the participant was covered. This included the possibility of three separate statements, one for the Defined Benefit Plan, Retirement Income Plan 1987 and Retirement Income Plan 2000. With the implementation of the Combined Minimum Monthly Benefit option and creation of Future Service Credit in conjunction with the reopening of the Defined Benefit Plan as of January 1, 2003, it became all the more apparent that it was important to integrate the information for the various benefit plans into one statement to reflect the inter-relatedness between the Plans.

In order to accomplish this, the Fund Office and

its plan professionals took much care in the development and preparation of these comprehensive statements which are intended to provide participants with valuable information on their accrued and projected benefits earned with this Fund. The project required a significant level of computer programming to combine the data from each plan and several testing phases to generate accurate projections based on the selected criteria. The end result has generated many positive comments from plan participants who appreciate the combined statement concept and the projection of potential future benefits.

The Fund Office certainly appreciates the patience of all participants for the extended period that it took the Fund to complete this complicated task this year. If, to date, you have not received a 2004 Annual Pension Statement, please contact the Pension Fund Office and we will research your situation and get one out to you in a short period of time. Otherwise, we anticipate that future Annual Statement mailings will return to a normal turn-around period since only minor adjustments to the programming may be necessary. ■
